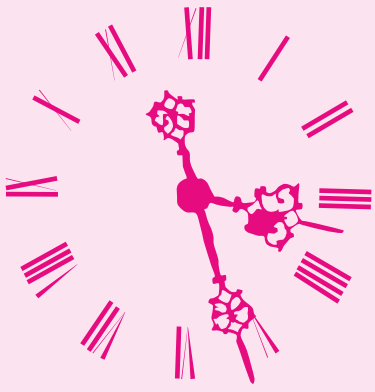

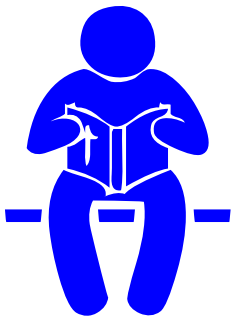


Daylight Saving Time starts March 14th
