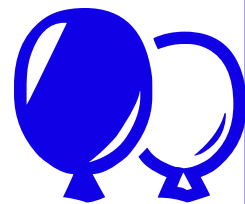

There are two very exciting events coming up for middle and high school students. Even if you don't have (m)any in this age group in your pews, I hope that you will consider inviting a few from your community to join us. Here are a few ideas:

Plan to attend yourself! We'd love to have you! Then you're inviting students or families to "come with you" rather than just inviting them to "go" from you. We'll make sure you're stocked with good coffee :-)

Sponsor another adult or parent to attend, one whom students gravitate towards. They can invite students to join them on the adventure! Sponsor a student leader to attend - who can then invite a few friends. This student can serve as an ambassador for next year's event. Host an info night - I would love to join you in person or via zoom to share more information about these events.

Although students and leaders can register themselves through our portal, it is ideal if they register through their home church. That means that you or a person you designate would take their information and send it to me on their behalf. The benefit to this method is that you are actively involved in praying for them, supporting them, and following-up after the event. We also strongly encourage an adult leader join us if any youth are coming from your area - a shared experience goes a long way in helping students connect and stay connected.

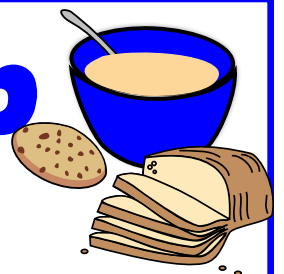
