SALISBURY, Md. – Wicomico County residents will have the chance to dispose of hazardous household waste for free next month. On Saturday, October 15th, residents of Wicomico County can bring their hazardous waste to the Newland Park

Landfill between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. Participants should bring valid proof of residence such as a driver's license. The landfill will accept items such as gasoline, bleach, batteries, fluorescent bulbs, pool chemicals, painting products, pesticides, ammonia, automotive fluids, and more. The landfill will not accept explosives, tires, medical waste, ammunition, radioactive material, or business industrial or commercial farm waste.
