REFORMATION, also called **Protestant Reformation**, is the religious revolution that began from an ongoing concern for renewal in the Roman Catholic Church that had been brewing for years. It came to fruition when many reformers within the medieval church attacked popular superstitions in the church and urged the imitation of Christ as the supreme moral teacher. Luther is said to have posted his Ninety-five Theses on the door of the Castle Church, Wittenberg, Germany, on October 31, 1517, the eve of All Saints' Day—the traditional date for the beginning of the Reformation. To understand our connection, Anglicanism is a particular Christian tradition born out of the Protestant Reformation in England. It was established by King Henry VIII in 1534. Known as the Church of England, it separated from the Roman Catholic Church for political reasons rather than theological disputes. The Episcopal Church, in its current form, is an offshoot of the Church of England. The American Episcopal Church was founded in the aftermath of the American Revolution, when Anglican adherents set aside the name “Church of England.”

This history let's us see the ways St. Alban's can share with Faith as they celebrate Reformation Day!
